(2) This residency restriction creates the possibility of not filling all seats available, despite having willing candidates who do not satisfy the residency requirements. (3) The Board of Education proposes removing these residency requirements and allowing candidates for the Board of Education to run at-large and without restriction by their area of residence within the School District. (4) In accordance with 105 ILCS 5/10-10.5, this proposition to elect board members at-large and without restriction by area of residence within the district shall be deemed to have passed if: (i) a majority of those voting at the election in each congressional township comprising the territory of the School District, including any congressional township of less than 100 inhabitants, vote in favor of the proposition, or (ii) two-thirds of all voters voting on the proposition vote in favor of the proposition.
