

The DeWitt County Property Committee is accepting bids to replace the existing pneumatic control system with an electronic control system.

Packets may be picked up at the DeWitt County Building, County Administrator's office, 201 W. Washington St., Clinton, IL 61727 or on the county website – dewittcountyill.com - main page "RFP Electronic Control System".

Bids must be received no later than October 4, 2019 at 3:30 p.m. Bids will be opened at the property committee meeting on October 9, 2019 at 7:00 a.m.

DeWitt County reserves the right to accept, negotiate or reject any or all bids. This project requires conformance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act.

Bid Specification for replacing the existing pneumatic control system with an electronic control system at the DeWitt County Building

Furnish labor and material to disconnect and remove existing pneumatic control system that is presently running five (5) existing air handling units for the county building area. Furnish and install new PROLON electronic control system, along with all new Belimo actuators.

This PROLON system will be set up to run a constant supply temperature, along with static duct pressure sensing the fan speeds to accommodate according to the set points the County designates.

Furnish and install four (4) new economizer controls to bring outdoor air in and lock out the condensing unit to provide free cooling when the outside temperature allows for it. Furnish and install/mount new thermostat controls to operate the zone actuators and pull the associated wire to control the system to the electrical system.
