

## PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES

**DATE OF MEETING:** August 11, 2022 at 7:00 a.m. County Building

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** David Newberg – Chari, Christy Pruser – Vice Chair, Megan Myers, and Claro Carter. Also, Dee Dee Rentmeister, County Administrator. Brian Riddle arrived at 7:01 a.m.

**MEMBERS ABSENT:** none

### **SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION:**

- No one to address the committee.
- Motion by Carter, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pruser to approve the June 2022 minutes. Voice vote, motion carried.
- Motion by Pruser, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Myers to approve the claims. Voice vote, motion carried.
- Micah Gallardo, EMA Coordinator, requested approval to attend the IEMA Summit in Springfield September 7-9, 2022 for himself and his assistant coordinator. Cost is \$150.00. Motion by Pruser, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carter to approve travel request for the EMA Coordinator and Assistant Coordinator. Voice vote, motion carried.
- Sheriff Walker updated the committee on the following:
  - One deputy short and may be one more short if a current deputy goes to the State Police.
  - Fully staffed in Corrections.
  - The new body cameras are here
  - Working on installing new laptops in squad cars
  - Increase in the power bills. Average 15 inmates. Shutting off lights in areas that are not being used.
  - General discussion on the reduction in revenue due to the upcoming Safety Act that goes into effect January 1, 2023
- Myers questioned why cage cards are not on all the cages since it's required by State law. Donny Benson, Animal Control Administrator, indicated that at the last inspection he was told that as long as all of the information on the animals was kept and readily available the cage cards weren't needed. Myers felt that the metal cage card holders should be purchased and put on all cages. Donny will get cage cards on all cages.
- Carter stated that he felt that there was not an effort being made to get rid of the cats at the shelter. He also stated that the last time he was out there he felt that there were areas that were not sufficiently cleaned. There was brief discussion about only authorized personnel being in the animal areas.
- Myers questioned why a rabies report hasn't been run. She stated that she picked up the folder about the software program from the treasurer's office on how to run reports. She will forward this information to Donny. Also discussed that the rescue groups are not being notified when the shelter has animals for adoption. Donny stated that once an animal is ready for adoption they are notified. General discussion on purchasing a new software program. Will talk with IT to see about transferring data from the old program to a new program - if possible.
- Discussion on the Saturday hours for the last 6 weeks. Donny indicated that there was a total of 7 visitors, 5 phone calls, 1 adoption and 1 rabies tag during the 6 weeks. Donny stated that he called around nearby animal control shelters and if they are even open on Saturdays it's only for a half day. After discussion, a motion was made by Pruser, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Riddle to return to a work schedule of Monday thru Friday with appts on Saturday if needed. Roll call vote as follows: Newberg aye, Pruser aye, Riddle aye, Carter nay, and Myers nay. Motion carried.
- General discussion on the increase in the electric bills.
- Motion by Myers, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pruser to adjourn at 7:54 a.m. Voice vote, motion carried.
